How to enable or disable mobile data

You can disable mobile data at any time to avoid overage or roaming charges, or to save your phone battery. See the steps to follow depending on your phone model.

iPhone

- 1 Open **Settings** and select **Cellular**.
 - 2 Enable or disable the **Cellular** or **Mobile Data** option.

SAMSUNG

- 1 Open **Settings** and select **Connections**.
 - 2 Go to the **Data Usage** section.
 - 3 Enable or disable the **Mobile Data** option.

Others (Android)

- 1 In **Settings**, select (depending on your model):
 - > Google (Pixel): **Network and Internet** > **SIM Cards** > **Videotron**
 - > Motorola: **Network and Internet** > **Mobile Network**
 - > TCL: **SIM Card and Mobile Network** > **Data Usage**
- 2 Enable or disable the **Cellular Data** or **Mobile Data** option.
